Change of name: Ms Sexton in Swan 4 is now Ms Cronje.


ATTENDANCE

On our Professional Development Day our staff discussed the results and we will be making some minor changes to our Attendance Plan. As with all our changes, we will be trying to improve by being positive and supportive.

All students who had regular attendance in Semester 1 will be receiving an acknowledgement certificate from me.

I was extremely proud of the 71 students who attended every day of Semester 1. My congratulations go out to those children and families.



Envelopes and money to be given to the photographer on the day of photo shoot.




CANTEEN NEWS
