My thanks go to Mr Hall for allowing me to use some space in this week's newsletter to introduce myself to the Banksia Grove Primary School community. My name is Stephen Bevan and I have the privilege of being the foundation principal at East Banksia Grove Primary School (planning name).

2019 will be the 30th year that I have worked in education as a teacher, deputy principal and principal. In this time I have taught in many rural and metropolitan schools and am very excited with the opportunity to open a new school in Banksia Grove.

This term I will begin working with members of the local community to decide on important things like the name of the new school, its uniform and colours as well as its motto and logo. I will be working closely with Mr Hall and his team at Banksia Grove Primary School to ensure that children enrolling at the new school continue to receive an outstanding quality of education.

Construction of the new school will commence shortly, with work on the Kindergarten/Pre-primary area to be completed ready for the start of school in 2019. The remainder of the school will be constructed throughout 2019 ready for Year 1 to 6 students to commence in 2020.
